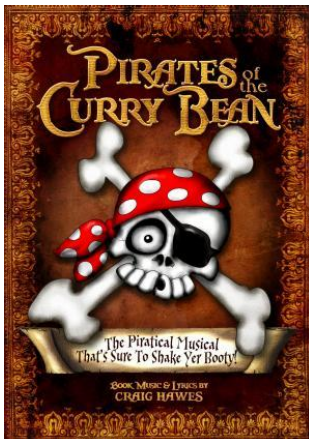


Year 6 Gorillas Newsletter: June 2022

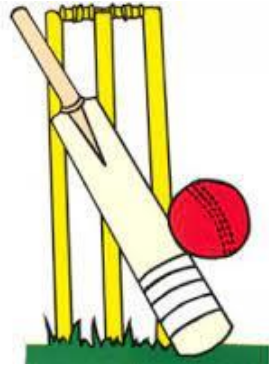
